

## Library Toolbar

### Introduction

---

The UWS library has developed the above toolbar that will aid you in finding information. The toolbar works in two ways; manually you can drag, type or right click information to search for items or automatically where the toolbar will scour pages that you are on and highlight information that you can access; this means that you can be in any site, on any page, either off campus or on and the toolbar will highlight information that you have available to you through UWS.



The UWS toolbar will access information in 3 ways:

- Having the user type in a search
- Right clicking your mouse over an item
- Dragging text to the scholar feature
- Context sensitive highlighting of items on a page

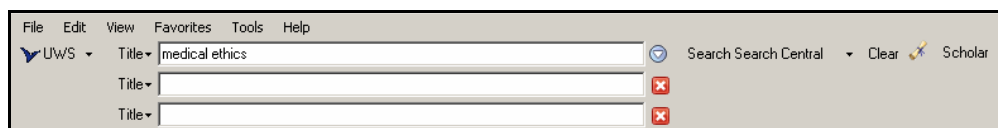
### Using the toolbar

---

- **Typing a search:** The toolbar will search the UWS Search Central Service as a default. Simply type your search terms into the toolbar and press enter. A new window will pop and conduct the search for you.



If you select the 'add fields' button  from the toolbar, you will be able to add more search terms to your search:



Remember: Search Central results are clustered meaning that you can narrow down your search by selecting one of the topics from the Clustered Results pane.

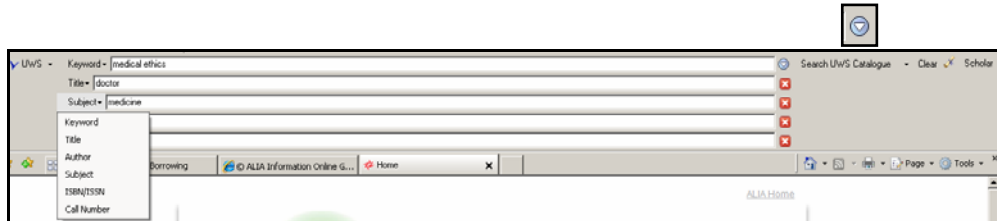
You can also do the same search in the UWS catalogue. To do this, you need to select 'Search UWS catalogue' from the pull down menu on the toolbar:



This will now change where you are searching on the toolbar:

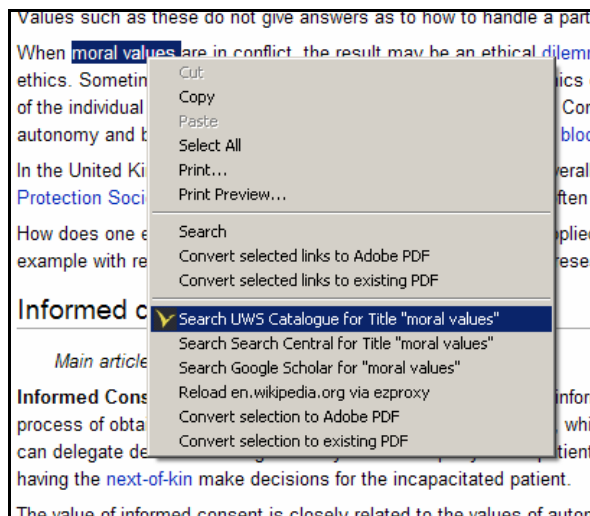



To change the fields you search in, click on 'keyword' and a menu of alternative option will appear. Press enter to initiate the search.



- **Right clicking over text to search:** Any text on any page can be highlighted and converted to a search by simply right clicking your mouse over it. This works in two ways.


You can right click over any text on any page and convert that text to a search by simply right clicking your mouse.





- **Dragging text to search options:** The UWS Library toolbar will also allow you to drag text to your preferred search option. Text can be dragged to two points on the search bar. The search button as well as the scholar icon  :



Once you have selected and dragged any text from any document on any webpage a pop up window will appear with your results. Dragging information to the search icon (either Search Central or UWS catalogue) will

yield results from that database. Dragging to the scholar icon  will yield results from both the library and google scholar. If the item is a journal article and it is accessible through the UWS library service you will be presented with the article.

- **Context sensitive resource linking:** The library toolbar will also highlight items on your page that are searchable through the UWS Library service. This feature will appear on any page that you are on and links are highlighted with the UWS icon  (see example below) click on the UWS icon to check our resources for the item:



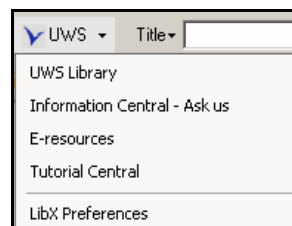
